

Storbritannia i Council of Europe Biomedical Ethics Committee. Hazel Thornton er pasientenes talskvinne. Etter en mammografi ble hun invitert til å være med i en kontrollert undersøkelse, men avslo på grunn av dårlig informasjon til pasientene, og senere har hun arbeidet for at pasienter skal delta aktivt i slike undersøkelser. Iain Chalmers er lege og en erfaren helsetjenesteforsker, har ledet Cochrane Center og leder nå James Lind Center som arbeider for bedre kvalitet og større vekt på etikk i testing av behandling.

Budskapet er dels en bitende kritikk av deler av den testingen som har foregått og fremdeles foregår, og dels en appell om «fair testing», dvs. en testing som holder både faglige og etiske mål. Fremstillingen er delt i åtte kapitler. Kapittel 1 er historisk og viser hvordan noen behandlinger har hatt skadelig effekt og hvordan andre ikke har innfridd forventningene. Testing er et vanskelig farvann som krever stø kurs. Kapittel 2 viser at mange behandlinger og screeningundersøkelser mangler vitenskapelig dokumentasion. I kapittel 3 drøftes alle de viktige detaljene som må være på plass for å unngå «bias» og holde egeninteressene i tømme. Kapittel 4 handler om «usikkerhetens lov» i all helsetjeneste og hvordan den må takles. Kapittel 5 viser forskiellene mellom god, dårlig og unød"This is an important, scary and encouraging book."

vendig forskning. Kapittel 6 er provoserende og dokumenterer at forskning ofte styres av økonomiske eller akademiske egeninteresser og ikke tar opp de spørsmålene som er viktige for pasientene. I kapittel 7 argumenteres det sterkt for å involvere pasientene og deres organisasjoner i testingen av behandling, selv om heller ikke dette er farefritt. Kapittel 8 er forfatternes oppskrift for en nødvendig revolusjon i arbeidet med å teste behandlings- og screeningmetoder.

Dette er en ganske liten bok. Den har en knapp og effektiv stil, nødvendige referanser og et godt sakregister. Den bæres oppe av et brennende engasjement, og budskapet kan sammenfattes i to ord: «fair testing». Jeg leste den fordi to anmeldelser gjorde inntrykk på meg (1, 2), og jeg ble ikke skuffet.
